

2023 U.S. Tour: Reaching Across America

In 2023, World Bridge Foundation embarked on an ambitious tour across the United States with Uganda's youth ensemble; *Dance of Hope*, leaving an indelible mark on communities from coast to coast. The tour was a testament to our commitment to fostering cross-cultural connections and empowering young minds through the transformative power of art.

Our journey spanned 14 states with countless connections, from the picturesque landscapes of Vermont, through the vibrant streets of Chicago, to the ski resorts of South Lake Tahoe. We encountered enthusiastic audiences eager to embrace our cultural exchange programs.



Tour Highlights

Engaging workshops and performances

Through workshops and performances, we directly impacted approximately 15,000 children. These interactive sessions not only showcased the talents of our young Ugandan performers but also provided a platform for American students to join in, creating unforgettable collaborative experiences.

90 Children: Education Funded

In Uganda, the tour's success was felt far beyond the borders of the United States. Thanks to the generous supporters that booked our programs, we were able to raise enough funds to send 90 children to school for an entire year. This achievement is a testament to the transformative potential of our programs.

Strengthening Communities

Beyond the numbers, the tour forged lasting connections with communities across the U.S. We witnessed firsthand the power of art to bridge cultural divides and inspire unity. We carry forward the lessons learned and the memories created to continue this journey and reach even more communities to leave an enduring legacy of empowerment.

Exemplifying the power of human spirit and hailed as Africa's most impactful youth-led endeavors, Dance of Hope cultivates a group of extraordinary young individuals who defy adversity and emerge as resilient ambassadors of creativity, hope and change.

Key Features:

Global Reach and Impact

Dance of Hope aims to inspire, empower, and connect people and communities globally. This impact is profound, shaping not only the lives of these young performers but also contributing to the larger vision of a world where every child, regardless of their circumstances, has access to artistic expression, and the opportunity to shape a brighter future.

Holistic Development

Goes beyond performance to nurture exceptionally vulnerable children, equipping them to become artistically excellent teachers and educators, not just performers. Emerging from extremely challenging circumstances, these individuals receive support and education through M-LISADA, a trusted Ugandan partner, then embark on a global journey as performers, sharing their stories of courage, hope, and triumph.

The funds raised from Dance of Hope's performances go toward vital aspects of the children's lives, including education, medical care, artisan training and the overall well-being in impoverished communities where these children live. This comprehensive approach empowers them to rise above their circumstances, emerging as self sufficient, confident and hopeful individuals.




